Reconnaissance and mine sweeping missions, took part in the Otranto bay mission, transported some personnel for German subs, missions along the Italian coasts (including antisubmarine etc) including landing on Pelagosa island, saved survivors from the SMS LIKA, towed away the damaged SMS TRIGLAV, escorted convoys, assisted some subs in distress, salvaged a seaplane, laid some mines. Faced a lot of engine problems ever since trial runs. Taken to Venice by Italians, paraded. Renamed FASANA but finally cannibalized and scrapped.
